

## What is this role / apprenticeship?

An associate project manager possesses the ability to determine project goals, strategies, duration, and costs, collaborating with the project team to achieve desired outcomes. Essential skills include effective planning, organisation, leadership, management, and communication. They ensure the assembly of a motivated and integrated team with appropriate skills, qualifications, experience, and knowledge, maintaining clear reporting lines, roles, responsibilities, and authorities. Job titles may vary based on organization size and project complexity, such as assistant project manager, junior project manager, or project team leader.

## How long does the apprenticeship take?

The apprenticeship will take around 24 months to complete.
