

What is this role / apprenticeship?

A team leader/supervisor is a first-line management role. Ensuring that employees are formally trained at this level will benefit both employees and the organisation by ensuring that employees have the skills and confidence to support their team effectively. An effective team leader/supervisor will provide direction, instructions and guidance to ensure the achievement of organisational goals. A team leader/supervisor apprenticeship teaches you about:

- Supporting, managing and developing team members
- Managing projects
- Planning and monitoring workloads and resources
- Delivering operational plans
- Resolving problems
- Building relationships internally and externally.

How long does the apprenticeship take?

The apprenticeship will take between 18-24 months to complete.

What qualifications will the learner receive?

- Level 2 Certificate in Functional Skills Mathematics
- Level 2 Certificate in ICT
- Institute for Apprenticeships Team Leader / Supervisor Level 3, achievable at Pass or Distinction.
